International Design Leaders Converge in Hong Kong for DFA Awards An award publication features each of the winning design excellence

[HONG KONG, 8 December 2018] A multitude of DFA Awards collateral events celebrating design excellence stemming the region and recognising the highest level of design thinking, innovation from an Asian perspective were just completed in applauses. The Hong Kong Design Centre kicked-off events with the presentation ceremony acknowledging 187 industry leading design projects through the DFA Design for Asia Awards as well as 16 emerging local forces with the DFA Hong Kong Young Design Talent Award. Following on, three major awards were conferred at the Business of Design Week (BODW) Gala Dinner, in front of the world's leading designers and business leaders - DFA Lifetime Achievement Award to Sir Terence Conran, an English designer, restauranteur, retailer and writer; DFA Design Leadership Award to Dr. Andrew Dent, a leading expert on sustainable materials; DFA World's Outstanding Chinese Designer to Mr. Lyndon Neri and Ms. Rossana Hu, architects, interior and product designers.

Professor Eric C. Yim, JP, Chairman, Hong Kong Design Centre stated that "This year the DFA Awards reaffirmed its position as a leading and visionary advocate of forward-thinking design. Across the five pillars of the Awards, from prominent design titans to emerging talents from Hong Kong, and designs in Asia and for Asia, the breadth and depth of Asian design thinking has been demonstrated through the 2018 awardees. Looking forward, as we build on the DFA Awards, we will continue with our mission to promote the design economy thus generating greater value across society."



Concurrent to BODW, selected winners were invited to share their design thinking and how it created impact for Asia at the **DFA: Design for Asia** and **Culture & The City** forums; an open to public exhibition featuring all winning projects of DFA Design for Asia Awards and portfolios of DFA Hong Kong Young Design Talent Award was held at the HKTDC Pavilion in DesignInspire.

After university and several years spent working for prestigious architecture firms in the US, teaching and conducting research, Lyndon Neri & Rossana Hu set up Neri&Hu Design and Research Office, their own inter-disciplinary international architectural design practice, in Shanghai and founded Design Republic, a Shanghai retail concept store offering an outstanding collection of products created by the world's finest furniture designers. Their vision is of modernity balanced by heritage, and their design practice embodies architecture, interior design, product and graphic design, and visual imaging. They approach architecture in a fundamental way, grounding design within the canon of western architecture, exploring forms, styles and tectonics with references to history and typological contexts. They see cultural identity as a natural outcome of who they are and where they come from, and believe that their background will inevitably surface in whatever they do.

DFA Design for Asia Awards 2018

DFA Design for Asia Awards received over 1,000 entries from 18 economies submitting design projects for consideration this year, with the judging panel selecting 187 design projects to be recognised, all of which launched available in Asian markets. A total of 10 Grand Awards, 3 Grand Awards for Culture, Sustainability, and Technology, 10 Grand Awards for Special Mention, and 164 winners from the Category Award are conferred. Among the winners, design projects from Japan and Hong Kong stand at the top of leaderboard, each with 55 winning projects, followed by Mainland China with 40 winning projects.

DFA Hong Kong Young Design Talent Award 2018

Fosters the development emerging design practitioners or graduates of 35 years old or under from Hong Kong. In 2018, 13 out of 16 winners would be awarded up to HK\$ 5 million in total in financial sponsorship for overseas attachments to incubate visions and provide opportunities for cross-cultural exchange projects. The programme seeks to cultivate the next generation of home-grown design to broaden exposure to the global design landscape, and to spearhead Hong Kong Design and Creative industry's future development by taking the essence of their overseas experience back to the city.
