(HONG KONG, 1 December, 2023) The DFA Awards 2023 organised by Hong Kong Design Centre with Create Hong Kong of the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region as the Lead Sponsor, a high recognition of excellence in design in Asia, concluded series of events including the Presentation Ceremony with resounding success. During the Presentation Ceremony, global design elites and business leaders witnessed the exceptional atmosphere of Asia design with over 200 awardees.

The highlight of the DFA Awards 2023 was the Presentation Ceremony on 28 November with over 300 attendees, where a total of 216 **DFA Design for Asia Awards** and 17 **DFA Hong Kong Young Design Talent Award** were bestowed upon this year's deserving winners. Notable guests including Mr. Sunny Tan, Member of the Legislative Council of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, Mrs. Lowell Cho, Assistant Head of Create Hong Kong of the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, and esteemed previous winners of the DFA Awards, such as Ms. Guo Pei, Mr. Freeman Lau, Ms. Kai-yin Lo and Mr. Henry Steiner, attended and graced the presentation ceremony.



Professor Eric Yim, Chairman of Hong Kong Design Centre said, "I am glad to witness the precious moment of recognising these excellent designers and design projects. This year, the DFA Awards give recognition to a total of 236 designers and projects, including the winners of the three most respectable awards, marking the highest number in our history, showing the design excellence in Asia."

The Awards reached their climax with this year's three most respectable awards conferred at the Business of Design Week (BODW) Gala Dinner on 29 November, witnessed by attending global design elites and esteemed business leaders. To highlight the significance of the three major awards, notable pairs of guests were invited to serve as presenters for each award. Ms. Kai-yin Lo, Chairman of Yin Expressions Limited along with Mr. Stanley Wong, Founder of 84000 Communications Limited, presented the DFA Lifetime Achievement Award (DFA LAA) to Mr. Kenya Hara; Professor Eric Yim, Chairman of Hong Kong Design Centre, along with Dr. Kigge Mai Hvid, Partner of JA Studio, presented the DFA Design Leadership Award (DFA DLA) to Mr. Victor Lo Chung-wing; while Mr. Steve Leung, Vice-chairman of Hong Kong Design Centre and Chairman of the judging panel for the DFA World's Outstanding Chinese Designer (DFA WOCD), along with Mr. Alan Chan, Founder of Alan Chan Design Company, presented the DFA World's Outstanding Chinese Designer to Ms. Jiang Qiong Er.

The DFA Lifetime Achievement Award 2023 celebrates Kenya Hara's enduring impact on design philosophy, his talent for making the ordinary extraordinary.

DFA Design Leadership Award 2023

Victor Lo Chung-wing / Chairman and Chief Executive of Gold Peak Technology Group

As the leader of Gold Peak Technology Group, Victor Lo's vision and commitment have made Gold Peak a leader in batteries and electronics industries worldwide. Lo's commitment to advancing innovation and technology, arts and culture is equally commendable. DFA World's Outstanding Chinese Designer 2023 Jiang Qiong Er / Designer, Co-founder of SHANG XIA

Jiang's design philosophy centres on emotion, harmonising tradition with modernity, craft with technology, and functionality with emotion. Jiang's dedication to cultural exchange and innovation has garnered prestigious accolades. The DFA World's Outstanding Chinese Designer 2023 honours Jiang Qiong Er as a visionary leader, adapt at bridging tradition and innovation, and a substantial contributor to the global design landscape.

DFA Design for Asia Awards 2023

In the 2023 edition, a total of 216 awards are granted to acknowledge the design excellence. Among these awards, there are 10 Grand Awards, 19 Gold Awards, 40 Silver Awards, 55 Bronze Awards and 92 Merit Awards presented. Design projects from Hong Kong tops the leaderboard with 58 winning projects, followed by the Mainland and Japan claiming 52 and 47 winning projects respectively. All the awards symbolise the range of achievements encompass a holistic celebration of design excellence and innovation.

DFA Hong Kong Young Design Talent Award

The DFA Hong Kong Young Design Talent Award aims to nurture Hong Kong designers or graduates aged between 18 and 35 in Hong Kong. Among the 17 awardees in the 2023 edition, 13 of them will be entitled for financial sponsorship to work or study outside Hong Kong to expand their horizon and acquire valuable experience, contribute to their personal development and Hong Kong creative industries.
